1. Performers speak words and phrases they recorded in as many ways as possible.
2. Performers improvise melodies from phrases they recorded.
3. Performers make rhythmic loops from phrases they recorded.
4. Performers incessantly repeat the last word to be spoken before the section begins.
5. Performers turn a phrase they recorded into a popular song.

Each part begins with performers singing in unison (as directed by conductor):

“Directions to Donegal County Council, Letterkenny, County Donegal, Ireland”

Performers then perform their individual directions, attempting not to overlap *too* much with other performers.

Performers should interpret directions musically as they see fit, e.g. a roundabout could produce a siren-like glissando.

Any sounds are welcome, including (but not limited to): tones, noises, rhythms and loops.
